**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

For increased rate of weight gain:

Feed 2-6 lbs of Calf Grower B-68, Med. to calves from 4 months of age (300 lbs.) to provide 60-200 mg of lasalocid per head per day. The table shows the amounts of Calf Grower B-68, Med. to provide 60-200 mg of lasalocid.

For control of coccidiosis:

Feed Calf Grower B-68, Med. to calves from 4 months of age (300 lbs.) to 8 months of age. Each pound will provide 34 mg of lasalocid. Feed according to table to provide 1 mg of lasalocid per 2.2 lbs. of bodyweight per day.

The safety of lasalocid in unapproved species has not been established. Do not allow horses or other equines access to Type A articles or Type B feeds containing lasalocid as ingestion may be fatal. Feeding undiluted or mixing errors may result in an excess lasalocid concentration which could be fatal to cattle and sheep.
